

Old Pueblo Anesthesia (OPA) is a physician-only private practice anesthesia group that has served the Tucson community for 44 years. It is comprised of over 40 physicians, all of whom are board certified or board eligible by The American Board of Anesthesiology. OPA is the exclusive anesthesia provider at Tucson Medical Center (TMC), a large tertiary-care community hospital that serves a diverse and growing population and performs all surgical cases with the exception of trauma, organ transplants, and pediatric hearts. TMC is one of the busiest obstetric, orthopedic, cardiac, and pediatric facilities in the state of Arizona. We have a full complement of board-certified pediatric surgeons, urologists, gastroenterologists, ENT, and orthopedic surgeons.

OPA is seeking to expand our pediatric anesthesia sub-group. All our current pediatric specialists are fellowship trained and/or board certified in pediatric anesthesia. We are looking for candidates who meet the following criteria (both experienced physicians and new fellows are welcome to apply):
